25 October 1493 The Lords of Council decree that John Arnot of that Ilk shall pay to Sir Thomas Myretoune, parson of Ryny, the sum of ten pounds Scots, long overdue payment.

1548-9 (25 February) An inquest finds Johne McWilliam McAlbin to be nearest heir to his "fader broder" (Sir) Donald Williamson chepland within the Cathedrall Kirk, whereupon (Sir) John Gibsoun protested in the name of Master Johne Leslie, persoun of Ryne, and tutor of John Williamsone, that this decision be of no prejudice to the said John.
