<p>1545 (1 May) - (Sir) Thomas Wallace person of Unthank, is a witness to charter of Patrick Hepburn, bishop of Moray and commendator of Scone, in favour of Hugh Rose of Kilravock.</p>				
<b>Thomas Wallace</b>	<i>Prebendary</i>	1542	<i>The Chiefs of Grant Vol 3</i>	371
<p>16 January 1542. Witnesses a charter of Patrick Hepburn, bishop of Moray, to Duncan Grant giving him the lands of Easter Ellochy (Elchies), with fishings on the water of Spey, in the barony of Strathspey, regality of Spyne. Given in the Chapter House of the Cathedral.</p>
