Agreement is between Malcolm (I), earl of Fife, and Andrew, bishop of Moray, and the chapter of Moray, over the lands of Advie, 'Inveraldeny', 'Dunyn', 'Brydeletheny', 'Mychel', 'Newyn, 'Christ', 'Tulacharum', 'Douenald', 'Kynnef', 'Martyn', 'Fyskelmor', 'Abyrbradalum', 'Brenyn', 'Doaskyn', 'Mychel'. The earl renounces in perpetuity and quitclaims to the mensa of the bishopric of Moray all the land of Advie by its right bounds and with its just pertinents, as well as the churchlands of Invera'an, with the right which he was said to have in the advowson of that church, by its right bounds and with its just pertinents. The earl has also conferred the advowson of the church of Cromdale to the aforesaid bishop in perpetuity. The bishop and chapter have quitclaimed in perpetuity to the earl all the lands named above.

Excommunication of David Boys for non-payment of annates.

To clergy and notaries of St Andrews, Moray and elsewheresoever. Mandate as below. On 5th May 1481, Egidius Boys, precentor of Moray, curialis, following the Roman Court and legitimate procurator of David Boys, monk of St Thomas of Alberbrock, OSB, St Andrews diocese, and Prior of Ploscarden, said order, Moray diocese, by virtue of a public mandate dimitted in Camera, obliged said David for annates of the priory, to be paid within eight months under pains. And we thereupon declared him, and gave mandate that he should be pronounced excommunicate in default of payment. For several months he has de facto underlain this sentence and still underlies it with an obdurate mind, unlawfully taking up the fruits meanwhile. And Philip de Moscharon, merchant of Bruges, in name of himself and So. likewise obliged himself under censures and pains for said David and annates of above priory ; and Egidius in said procuratorial name promised to hold Philip, seeing David heedless of paying annates and of incurring above censures, but wishing to satisfy his obligation, paid as annates 87.5 florins (g.c.) of his own money by hands of So. de Rabbatis and Ricasulis ; as is seen in Boks of Annates, lib. xii, fo. i, said David being freed from above censures (dicto Davide in censuris predictis nichil remane[n]te). In order, therefore, that Philip may recover the said 87.5 florins we, at mandate of Pope verbally delivered to us, and through our office as Chamberlain, by tenor of the presents grant and transfer to Philip all right and action competent to Apostolic Camera in said annates against said David for said 87.5 ducats [sic] of gold, empowering him to take action in whatsoever courts before whatsoever judges by himself or proxy, with cession to him of all and sundry the actions, rights and aids of both laws, competent to Camera in the cause.

the presents we give mandate to the above, together and severally, under pain of excommunication, that immediately on receipt of the presents, on being required by foresaid Philip and So., you personally or by proxy in your churches, monasteries and chapels of all Sundays and feasts during the solemnities of masses and other divine hours in the congregation of the people, with ringing of bells, candles being lighted and extinguished and cast on the ground, do publicly proclaim said David to be excommunicate until he have made full satisfaction of the sum of 87.5 florins to said Philip and So. By your letters patent or public instrument you will notify us faithfully of what you have done or caused to be done in the premises. We reserve to ourself or our superior absolution from sentences that may be incurred.
